



Is Your Power Bank Still in Good Condition?

CHECK • REPLACE • RECYCLE



There's no fixed lifespan that applies to every power bank. What actually matters is condition, performance, and technology - not age. Here's what to look for.

NORMAL WEAR

- ✓ Slightly slower charging than when new
- ✓ Holds slightly less charge over time
- ✓ Feels mildly warm during use



WARNING SIGNS

- ⚠ Swelling, bulging or misshapen casing
- ⚠ Visible damage to the casing, ports or cable
- ⚠ Unusual smell, noise or excessive heat
- ⚠ Switches off unexpectedly or behaves inconsistently

Recycle your old Power Bank

DISPOSE OF IT RESPONSIBLY



In Australia, the right place for old batteries and power banks is B-cycle - the official national battery stewardship scheme.



DON'T BIN IT

Batteries and power banks don't belong in general waste or household recycling. It's a genuine fire and environmental risk.



COVER IT

Cover any terminals or ports with clear sticky tape before you transport or store it, to reduce fire risk.



TAKE IT

Drop it at your nearest B-cycle accredited drop-off point.
